OLD BUSINESS:

- A. **Another Bank** -Clerk Sweetalla has reached out to Florida League of Cities to get a bank name that will work with municipalities and do 2 signature checks. Chris Holly called back, even though he could not recommend a specific bank. He was able to offer some banks that some other municipalities are using. Chase, Renasant, Regency and Truist. I will reach out to the 3 that I have not tried yet. He said that the Big Bank Lobbyist are keeping the Credit Union out of the running to be able to bank with.
- B. **BMAP (Basin Management Action Plan)** - Council President Stokes who got the plan turned in before the January 16th deadline to bring us into compliance. She is still working with their department about septic Systems in place in Reddick.
- C. **Cell Phone Tower, Badges, Etc.** : Council President Nadine Stokes still checking in to.

- B. **Interfaith Food Pantry & Emergency Services Ministries:** The property does still belong to the school board. Ms. Vega has been given their information to contact them about filling in the pot-holes in the parking lot.
- C. **U.S. Census Bureau:** Clerk Sweetalla reached out to them to them to see what they expect from us. No word back from them yet.
- D. **Florida League of Cities:** We received an email from them this morning concerning 14 different Training Classes

- E. Reddick Days:** All in attendance of the February meeting would love to do. We need a resident to head up a committee to make the plans, etc.
- F. Park Pavillion:** We only have until the end of this year to get the park built and \$ spent or we have to pay the funds back to the state for the program. \$195,000 plus. Clerk Sweetalla reached out to the Park system (John Clarke Allen and Tracy Straub). Tracy and Jim Couillard have responded and requested additional information about the rules concerning the Funding from American Rescue Funds. I have sent them the original 16-page contract that was signed when we received the funding. We have \$45,678.15 left in the account A.R.F. account at Rensant Bank. I don't know if that will complete the Pavilion yet. I am waiting for the response from Tracy And Jim.
